

## Building permit is required before the start of the following projects

Please Note: This is <u>NOT</u> a complete list of all type of projects.

## **Exterior**

- Home / Structures
- Decks over 30" above grade with or without cover
- Porch/patio covers, awnings, carports
- Storage sheds
- Fence installation or replacement
- Lawn sprinklers systems
- Pools (above/In ground), hot tubs & spas
- Driveways & driveway extensions
- Public sidewalks (in right of way)
- Any room additions
- Attached or detached garages
- Accessory buildings
- Heating & A/C installations or replacements
- Patio enclosures
- Solar panel installation or replacement
- Gas line installation or replacement
- Electrical work (other than exchange of fixtures)
- Plumbing work (other than exchange of fixtures)
- Installation or replacement of windows and/or doors
- Installation or replacement of siding
- Installation, replacement, or repair of any structural component

## Interior

- Heating & A/C installation or replacement
- Water heater installation or replacement
- Boiler installation or replacement
- Gas log, gas lines, log lighters
- Fireplaces (wood, pellet, or gas)
- Remodeling
- Garage conversions
- Electrical work (other than exchange of fixtures)
- Plumbing work (other than exchange of fixtures)
- Mechanical work
- Structural modifications
- Replacement or repair of any structural component
- Installation or replacement of windows and/or doors
- Any increase in window or door sizes.

## Building Permits are not required for the following projects:

Exterior – General landscaping, wood decks less than 30 inches above grade without cover (Must be anchored properly to resist uplift), painting, and minor fence repair.

Interior – Painting, floor covering (carpet, linoleum, tile), wallpapering, replacement of plumbing fixtures, replacement of cabinets & countertops, adding insulation, changing light fixtures, and changing switches or outlets.

<u>Building Permits must be authorized and paid for prior to starting any building projects.</u> Building Projects started within the Collinsville City limits before obtaining the proper building permits is subject to an investigation.
